How to Get Fallen Away Members to Come Back (and Visitors)









2/3 of your visitors will not return!

- ► Even if you're friendly, it is not enough!
- Fallen away members?
- ► How do you get them back?



Take Ownership: Luke 15:4-6

4 "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? 5 And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. 6 And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!'

He calls them "My Sheep"!



He considered them HIS.


Sheep usually follow.

Some wander off.

- ► He knew them well.

- Rejoiced with his friends.

The Parable of the Lost Coin:

Refers to a piece of jewelry

Equivalent to wedding ring

Luke 15:8-10

⁸ "Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it? 9 And when she has found it, she calls her friends and neighbors together, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the piece which I lost!' 10 Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

Important things to note.....

- ►Knew one was missing.
- Took actions (efforts) to help the search.
- Rejoiced with her friends.



How do these apply to the church?

- ►Knew one was missing?
- ►Took multiple actions (effort) to help the search?
- ► Rejoiced?



If someone falls away or doesn't return what do you do?

- Ask the preacher or an elder?
- Send them a card?
- ▶ Visit them once?
- Speculate as to why they left?
- ► Nothing?

What can we learn?

- ► How is this perhaps like a fallen away member?
- ▶ What about the visitor?
- ► What has to happen before a visitor or fallen away member comes back?
- ▶ What must we do to keep them?
- Compare the elder brother to members in your congregation.

¹⁹ Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, ²⁰ let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save [a]a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.

What are these souls worth?






